## WORKSHOP DESCRIPTION

Since the unconscious purpose of marriage is to finish childhood, our role as therapists is to facilitate that process. If we help couples change the way they talk to each other and the content of what they say, we help them change and sustain the quality of their relationship. Imago Dialogue is a new way of talking that helps couples shift from negative judgments and criticisms to curiosity, acceptance, and connection. This shift from parallel monologues to dialogue helps couples make the journey from romantic love through conflict to real love by creating the emotional safety required for healing and growth. Participants in this workshop will be introduced to the Imago theory and therapy of couplehood—with an emphasis on the dialogue process—through lectures and live and video demonstrations. There will be an opportunity to practice.

- Discuss how marriage/committed partnership can be the source of deepest healing.
- Describe the three steps of Imago Dialogue.
- Practice the steps of the dialogue process.
- Experience the outcomes of Dialogue.
- List the three stages of marriage/committed partnerships.

Harville Hendrix, Ph. D., is co-founder, with his wife Helen LaKelly Hunt, Ph. D., of Imago Relationships International, a non-profit organization dedicated to international support and development of Imago Relationship Therapy. They are the creators of Imago Relationship Therapy and the concept of the “conscious partnership.” Dr. Hendrix is the author of two best sellers, *Getting the Love You Want: A Guide for Couples* and *Keeping the Love You Find: A Guide for Singles*, and a third best seller, co-authored with Helen, *Giving the Love They Need: A Guide for Parents*. They have also co-authored three mediation books, *The Couples Companion*, *The Personal Companion*, and *The Parents' Companion*. Their most recent books include *Receiving Love: Transform Your Relationship by Letting Yourself Be Loved*, *The New Couples Study Guide for Getting the Love You Want* and a *Manual for Receiving Love*. Their books have been translated into more than 50 languages and Imago Therapy is practiced in 30 countries by more than 2000 therapists. Dr. Hendrix has made seventeen appearances on the Oprah Winfrey Show, one of which won her first Emmy Award and was ranked by Ms. Winfrey in her top twenty shows. He has also been seen on many other TV shows and featured in many magazine and newspaper articles worldwide.

Dr. Hendrix is a clinical pastoral counselor with 40 years of experience as a therapist, educator, clinical trainer, author, and public lecturer. He has received many awards for his work with couples. He lives with his wife in New York and New Mexico and they have six children and four grandchildren.
